PARIS — AENEAS, a legal entity that represents nanoelectronics R&D partners in the ENIAC Joint Undertaking, announced it has named Marcel Annernargn as director general.

As director general of the Association for European Nanoelectronics Activities (AENEAS), Annernargn will be responsible for the management and coordination activities for Nanoelectronics R&D performers and their stakeholders within the ENIAC program. Based at the CATRENE office, he will see to ensure synergies between the programs.

Annernargn started his career at Philips Research in 1977 where he promoted Philips' positioning on the television and consumer electronics markets. In 2003, he joined Philips Semiconductors and was in charge of the development department in consumer electronics, including DVDs, audio, car infotainment and TVs.

From 2006 to 2008, Annernargn managed the Project Office Philips Semiconductors, later NXP Semiconductors, responsible for development processes, the creation of development roadmaps for future products, standardization and export control.

AENEAS was formed [in 2006](#) to provide the legal frame for the partnership with the European Commission and Member and Associated States in the context of the proposed Joint Technology Initiatives model.

AENEAS is non-profit industrial association established under French law.
