MEDEA+ announcing last call for project proposals

MEDEA+ is an industry-driven pan-European program for advanced co-operative Research and Development in micro- and nanoelectronics (EUREKA 2365). It now has announced its final and last call for project proposals, starting on May 15, closing it August, 29th, 2007. Next on the time-schedule is December 18th, 2007, where the decisions of project labelling will start, followed by an extensive evaluation and selection process. First project starts, being part of MEDEA+, are anticipated from January 2008 onwards.

Josez Cornu, Chairman of MEDEA+ said: "Considering the pace of the technical evolution in the nanoelectronics domain and the resulting business challenges

for Europe's high tech industry, we have to fully exploit the time-frame awarded to the MEDEA+ programme (2001–2008). This also means that projects started may continue their implementation even after 2008".

MEDEA+ has proven to be the leading European program in micro- and nanoelectronics supported by industry and European governments with already 47 ended and 30 still active projects. These resulted from the three calls of MEDEA+ Phase 1 and the two calls of Phase 2, with the involvement of over 380 organisations and, an average of 2500 researchers per year.

If you want to join MEDEA+, you got the (last) chance till August 29th, 2007.
